Betty Yvonne (Jenkins) Lund, 84 of Kearney passed to her eternal home Monday, December 30, 2019 at her home. Memorial services will be held 2:00 p.m. Friday January 3, 2019 at First Lutheran Church, 3315 Avenue G, Kearney, NE. in Kearney. The Rev. Dr. Michelle Holley Carlson and Rev. Dr. Rick Carlson will officiate. The family will receive friends 6:00 – 7:00 p.m. Thursday at O'Brien Straatmann Redinger Funeral Home and one hour prior to the service at the church.

Betty was born January 3, 1935 to Ivor and Mabel (Petersen) Jenkins in Wayne County, NE. She met the love of her life, Douglas Lund, at Nebraska Wesleyan University campus while crossing paths on the steps of Old Main. They were married at Bethany Christian Church in Lincoln, NE on June 7, 1958.

Because of Betty's love for children, she became an elementary teacher for Murdock Elementary. After two years of teaching she gave birth to her son, Scot, on May 24, 1960. On May 25, 1962, her daughter, Susie, was born and completed their family.

In the fall of 1962, Doug and Betty moved to Kearney where Doug began his career teaching Biology for Kearney State College. The community of Kearney was never the same. Betty never knew a stranger.
