Mary Lou "Bonnie" Horsley Burton, 86 of Kearney passed away Monday, March 9, 2020 at Mother Hull Home in Kearney. Funeral services will be 2:00 p.m. Friday, March 13, 2020 at the Pleasanton United Methodist Church with the Rev. Seung Park officiating. Interment will follow at Kearney Cemetery. Visitation will be held 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. Thursday at O'Brien Straatmann Redinger Funeral Home in Kearney and one hour prior to the service at the church.

Mary Lou "Bonnie" VanVleet Horsley Burton was born June 25, 1933 in St. Edward, NE, the fourth child of six born to Vern and Carrie (Dolan) VanVleet. She received her education in Gibbon and Kearney. Bonnie married Ralph E. Horsley of rural Minden. To this union five children were blessed; Kathryn Jean, Christine LaVonne, Rick R., Tamela Kristi, and Rod Scott. After Ralph's death in 1995, she married Robert W. Burton of rural Pleasanton, NE.

Bonnie's family and friends were a priority in her life. She enjoyed baking and cooking and published a family cookbook. She was gifted in embroidering. She made several quilts and throws for family members. She was active in the community as a member of the Women's Christian Temperance Union, the Sunflower Kensington Club, and a volunteer at both an assisted living facility and a nursing home. She enjoyed playing cards with her friends and at the Senior Center in Kearney. She donated toys to the Salvation Army at Christmastime and was a long-time supporter of St. Jude's Hospital.

Always active in her church, she served as the Kindergarten Sunday School teacher in the Kearney Church of the Nazarene for many years. She also served as a teacher for the Kids for Christ after school program at the United Methodist Church in Pleasanton. In 2014 she wrote the song "We Are Blessed." It was recorded in March 2015.

Her work experience included Head Start, Head of Housekeeping and Laundry at Mother Hull Home, housekeeping at Good Samaritan Hospital, and Day Care nursery attendant for fifteen years.

Bonnie also appeared in a commercial for the South Central Agency on Aging and in Joy Johnson's 2014 calendar of older women.

Left to cherish her memory are her daughters, Kathryn Thorne of Lincoln, Christine Dungan of Beatrice, and Tamela Sikes of Alma ; sons, Rick Horsley of Lincoln, and Rod Horsley of Kearney; 19 grandchildren; 23 great-grandchildren; sister, Betty Reeves of Omaha; sisters-in-law, Tillie VanVleet of Valley, and Dora Horsely of Minden; brother-in-law, Kenneth Marlatt of Chadron and several nieces, nephews and extended family and friends.

She was preceded in death by her parents; husbands, Ralph Horsley and Robert Burton; brothers, Don, LaVern, and Bobby VanVleet; and sister, Beverly Marlatt.
