Alice L. Thompson, 86, of Kearney died Monday, September 4, 2017 at CHI Good Samaritan Hospital in Kearney. She later taught school at Bristol School near Arcadia. On May 22, 1950, Alice was united in marriage to Garnet Thompson. To this union 4 children were blessed; Larry, Jerry, Marvin and Rae. Alice spent her time alongside of Garnet in self-employment at Thompson Repair and Hay Service in Loup City. In 1972, they moved to their

home near Odessa, NE where they owned and operated Reimer Feed Company. Alice worked at the Alfalfa Center School as a cook. She also worked as a certified Med Aid at Cambridge Court in Kearney from their opening until her retirement in 2009, when she sold her home and moved to Northridge Senior Living where she lived until her death.

Alice loved her family and always looked forward to spending birthdays, holidays and family reunions with them. She, like her mother, loved to bake. Alice's baking forte' was her homemade cinnamon rolls. Every child and grandchild not living at home got a panful for Christmas. Alice also loved to crochet afghans for all of her grandchildren. While living at Northridge, Alice enjoyed playing BINGO, Dominoes, Skip Bo, and Wii bowling. She was selected as an Ambassador by Northridge to greet new residents and show them "the ropes." She hung a birthday banner and delivered cards to every resident on her floor. Alice loved every craft class held at Northridge and made every birthday card for family and friends in recent years.

Alice joined Countryside Christian Church in the early 1970's and was a faithful member of Sunday School and Bible studies, as well as, the Sunday service. In her later years, the Larsen's would pick her up for church and Bible study and get her home again.
