Dale A. Glaze Jr., 64, of Elm Creek died Sunday, March 07, 2010 at Good Samaritan Hospital in Kearney. Funeral services will be held at 11:00 AM, Thursday, March 11 at the First Christian Church in Elm Creek with Rev. Tom Swartley officiating. He was born July 25, 1945 in Wichita, KS to Dale and Marjorie (Cunningham) Glaze. He grew up on a farm near Larado, KS, then moved to a farm outside Penalosa, KS. He received his education in Langdon, KS, then at Turon High school in Turon, KS until the 10th grade. He lived in several areas of Kansas, Estes Park, CO, and several areas of Nebraska. He spent 3 years in Fairbanks, AK. On July 24, 1969, he married Pamela Crouse in Alliance, NE. He later married Sandra D. Birth on July 1, 1988 in Lyons, KS. They lived in Sterling, KS for 2 years, then moved to Elm Creek, where he spent the remainder of his life. Dale worked as a ranch hand as a young man, then went into maintenance, working at the hospital in Fairbanks, AK, and the Great Plains Medical Center, finishing his working career at the University of Nebraska at Kearney. Dale loved the sandhills and working as a ranch hand, but his heart belonged to Alaska. Survivors include his wife, Sandra of Elm Creek; sons, Quirt A. Glaze of North Platte and Jack L. Belle Isle and his significant other, Cassie Scheuffele of Elm Creek;

daughters Shannon D. Belle Isle of Elm Creek, Marnia R. Hughes and husband Tony of North Platte, and Dawn M. Belle Isle and her significant other, Jason L. Forney of San Francisco; mother, Marjorie E. Nutter of Elm Creek; 7 grandchildren; 1 great grandchild; sister, Judy E. Saner and husband Duane of Cheyenne, WY; 1 niece, 2 nephews and 1 aunt. He was preceded in death by his father, Dale A. Glaze; stepfather, Fayette Nutter; and stepbrother, Kevin Nutter.
