Dave A. Middleton, 61 of Kearney died Monday, March 16, 2015 at his residence. Memorial services will be 4 PM, Friday at Family of Christ Lutheran Church in Kearney. The Rev. John Gosswein will officiate. Interment with military honors will be 2:00 PM, Saturday at the Peckham Cemetery in rural Gothenburg. The Rev. Jane Freeman will officiate. There will be a reception at the Banner Methodist Church following the graveside service. Memorials are suggested to the Family of Christ Lutheran Church. He was born on August 13, 1953 in Gothenburg to Sumner and Margaret (Hitchcock) Middleton. He grew up in Gothenburg. He was a 1971 graduate of Gothenburg High School. After graduation, he joined the Navy and served on the carrier, the USS Independence.

He was married to Debbie Schaaf in Kearney on May, 9, 1976. They made their home in Kearney. He worked for a time at Western Schwinn in Kearney. He later worked as a draftsman for various manufacturing companies including, DeLux Manufacturing in Kearney, Big Valley in Lexington and Coleman Powermate in Kearney.

He was a member of Family of Christ Lutheran. He was active in his church, serving as council president and played in the praise band. His pastimes included nature photography, duck hunting and music.

Survivors include his wife of Kearney, sons, Ben of Chicago and Sam of

Kearney, daughter, Ellie Krysl and husband, Robb of Ft. Collins, CO, brother, Stephen and wife, Katherine of Gothenburg, sister, Cate Russo and husband, Chuck of Phoenix, AZ, stepmother, Bev Middleton of Gothenburg, stepbrothers, Brian Haugen of Minnesota and Randy Haugen of Florida, stepsisters, Sandy Bennett of Florida and Joy Kuhlman of Gothenburg and uncle and aunt, Mike and Peg Hitchcock.

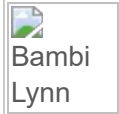

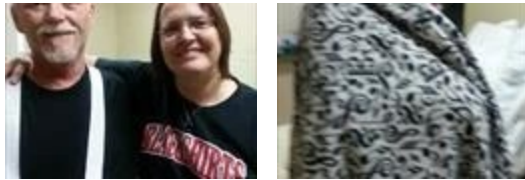
