Donald Eppenbach, 71 of Kearney died Sunday, April 23, 2017 at CHI Health Good Samaritan Hospital in Kearney. A memorial service will be 10:30 am Friday, May 5th at the O'Brien Straatmann Redinger Funeral Home in Kearney with Pastor Dean Pofahl officiating. Interment will follow at Kearney Cemetery with Military Honors provided by the American Legion Post # 52 and VFW Post # 759 in conjunction with the Offutt Air Force Base Honors Team.

Donald was born May 21, 1945 in O'Neill, Nebraska to Earl and Iris (Siewert) Eppenbach. He was raised on a ranch near O'Neill and was a 1963 graduate of O'Neill High School. Don entered into the United States Air Force later that year and was honorably discharged in 1967 after service in Texas, Lincoln, Massachusetts and Guam. On September 3, 1966, he was united in marriage to Juanita Weber in Lincoln, NE. The couple made their home in O'Neill, NE where he was employed by KN Energy in the service department. His job moved the family to Kearney in 1994. Don retired in 2002 after 35 years of

employment with KN Energy.

Don enjoyed golfing, hunting, fishing, woodworking and riding motorcycles. He was a longtime member of the American Legion Post #93, a lifetime member of the NRA and a member of the American Hunting Club and the Ft. Kearny Shooting Sports Association. Don was also known for his morning ritual of enjoying 6:00am breakfast at Burger King.

Survivors include his wife, Juanita of Kearney; daughters Debra (Bart) Luedtke of New Richmond, WI and Crystal (Jeff) Smith of Bellevue, NE; grandchildren Clairia Luedtke and Elliott Smith; sister Peggy (Dave) Sidak of O'Neill, NE; sister-in-law Marilyn (Robert) Hamilton of Smith Center, KS; aunt Leona Knox of Atkinson, NE; as well as, many nieces, nephews and cousins.
