He was drafted into the U.S. Army on April 21, 1953 and proudly served until his honorable discharge on April 20, 1955. Like many young men his age, Don was needed on the family farm so he returned home and continued farming until he retired. On December 29, 1957, he was united in marriage to Beverly Gruhn at St. Paul's

Lutheran Church in Kenesaw. To this union three children were blessed, Kathleen, Vivian and Glen.

Don was a member of Christ Lutheran Church where he was active in the church choir and men's choir. His hobbies included woodworking, hunting, golfing, fishing and being with family.
