Donald J. Theis, 87 of Gibbon passed away Thursday, April 4, 2024 at CHI Good Samaritan Hospital in Kearney. A memorial mass will be 10:30 a.m. Tuesday, April 9, 2024 at St. James Catholic Church in Kearney with Father Joe Hannappel officiating. Military honors will be provided by Kearney American Legion #52, VFW Post #759 in conjunction with the United States Navy Funeral Honors Team following the service at the church.
