Doris graduated from Kearney High School in 1932, then continued her study of Classical Piano and organ, as well as, teaching piano. On August 18, 1942, she was united in marriage to Emmett Wink of Kearney, and they made their home in Kearney. Doris was employed at Anderson Jewelry Store, A.S.C.S. office and the Kearney Air Base as a secretary. In 1947, the couple moved to Elm Creek where she was bookkeeper for the John Deere Dealership, which they owned and operated until 1972. Doris was a longtime member of the Immaculate Conception Catholic Church in Elm Creek. She served as organist there for 26 years. She was a member of the Woman's Club, the Kearney Mothersinger's, Sweet Adeline and the Hospital League Service in Kearney. In 1977, Doris and

Emmett lived for a time in Haiti, West Indies, where he was employed. After returning to their home in Elm Creek, as a hobby, Doris did crossword puzzle construction for publishing companies in New York and Florida. In 1984, they relocated back to Kearney, where she lived until her death. She was a member of St. James Catholic Church and Altar Society. Survivors include her sisters-in-law, Mary Lou O'Brien of Kearney, Joyce Wink of Kearney, Donna Wink of Washington D.C., Donna Wink of Enid, OK, as well as, many nieces and nephews. She was preceded in death by her husband; brothers, Donald, Rollie and Allen Frederick.
