Dorothy A. Carmann, 96, formerly of Riverdale, died Sunday, March 10, 2013 at Tiffany Square in Grand Island. She graduated from Amherst High School in 1933 and attended Normal School at Kearney State Teachers College before teaching at rural schools in the Sandhills south of Mullen and Districts 90 and 80 near Amherst. She was united in marriage to Rudolf Carmann in Peake St. Paul's Lutheran Church north of Riverdale on May 24, 1936. The couple farmed their entire married life north of Riverdale with their family. Her husband preceded her in death on May 24, 1977. Since 1954, Dorothy was a member of Trinity Lutheran Church in Amherst, NE, and was active in several church organizations including Sunday School, Vacation Bible School, Ladies Aid, Lutheran Women's Missionary League, and quilting groups. She greatly enjoyed extending hospitality through meals with family and friends in her home and by sharing her baked pies, cakes, brownies, and cookies. She had

a passion for writing letters and articles, playing piano, singing songs and hymns, visiting the elderly, and giving her quilts for baby and wedding gifts. She is survived by her sons, Glen M.
