January 5, 1943 - January 2, 2017

Douglas Gallant died of pneumonia, January 2, 2017 at St. Francis Memorial Hospital in West Point, Nebraska, at the age of 73 years. He was born January 5, 1943 to Neal and Jean Gallant, former teachers at Kearney Junior High School. He attended Kearney Public Schools. He was employed by the TB Hospital, City of Kearney and Arby's in Kearney. He was a member of Buffalo County ARC and First Presbyterian Church in Kearney and First Congregational Church of Scribner, where he attended regularly. He moved to Scribner, Nebraska in March of 2011 and resided at the Good Samaritan Center in Scribner. The past years of his life were enhanced by the caring attitude of staff at the Scribner Good Samaritan Center.
