Duane M. Hasty, 84 of Kearney passed away Saturday, June 11, 2022 at the Central Nebraska Veterans Home in Kearney. Graveside services will be 10:00 a.m. Friday, June 17, 2022 at Kearney Cemetery with Military Honors provided by Kearney American Legion Post #52, VFW Post #759 in conjunction with the Nebraska National Guard Funeral Honors Team.
