Dwight D. Farmer, 61 of Kearney passed away Wednesday, October 5, 2022 at CHI Good Samaritan Hospital in Kearney. Funeral services will be 10:30 a.m. Tuesday, October 11, 2022 at Zion Lutheran Church with Pastor Doug Gaunt officiating. Interment will follow at Custer Center Cemetery near Broken Bow, NE. Visitation will be held 5:00 to 7:00 p.m. Monday at O'Brien Straatmann Redinger Funeral Home in Kearney and one hour prior to the service at the church.

Dwight Douglas Farmer was born November 26, 1960 in Broken Bow, NE to James and Lucille (Allen) Farmer. He attended grade school at Rose Valley and graduated from Broken Bow High School in 1979.
