After college graduation Eddie moved to Las Vegas, NV for work. His mother relocated to North Platte, NE, where she met Leah O'Donnell. Leah was the love of Eddie's life and they were united in marriage on July 4, 1996. Eddie

and Leah were blessed with two boys, Logan Douglas (18) and Landan Dillon (16). Later they were both blessed by the gift of little Layna Danae (11). Eddie loved watching all of the children play sports, and even enjoyed music performances and dance recitals.

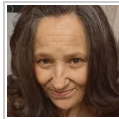
