Edith M. Bierman, 98, of Kearney died Tuesday, October 19, 2010 at St. John's Good Samaritan Center. Funeral services will be held at 10:30 AM, Friday, October 22 at the First United Methodist Church in Kearney with Rev. Gary Main officiating. Interment will be in the Kearney Cemetery. She was born April 6, 1912 on a farm near Proctor, CO to Homer and Emma (Hammond) Cain. She grew up on a farm in Phelps County, NE after her family had moved back to Nebraska. She attended a rural school through 8th grade and graduated from Holdrege High School in 1931. She attended Normal College in Kearney for a year, then taught in Phelps County rural schools for 6 years. On November 28, 1938, she married W. Lester Bierman in Kearney. They moved to Kearney and she lived here the rest of her life. She worked as a cashier and bookkeeper for J.M. McDonald's for over 30 years. After retiring, she helped with church bulletins at the church. She moved to Cambridge Court in 2003. She enjoyed crocheting doilies, bed spreads and, later on, baby caps for the Good Samaritan Hospital Volunteer Service League. She was a member of First United Methodist Church in Kearney for over 50 years. She was also active in the church circle, Kearney Women's Club and Good Samaritan Hospital Volunteer Service League. Survivors include her brother, Merlen Cain and wife Dorothy of Kearney; her sister, Alice Nelson of Casa Grande, AZ; and nieces and nephews. She was

preceded in death by her husband, Lester in 1993; brothers, Marvin, Arlen and Bert Cain; and sister, Ardith Lee.
