Eleanor M. Farrell, 88, passed away peacefully in Kearney, NE on June 5, 2026. Funeral services are pending.

Born in Seattle in 1938, she was the daughter of George and Enid Peter. She went to college at the University of the Pacific in Stockton, CA, where she met her future husband, Donald Farrell. She worked as an elementary school teacher while he went to medical school, first at Stanford University and then at George Washington University in Washington, D.C.. When he got a position at the University of Washington in 1971, they moved to Bellevue, and then Mercer Island, WA, where they raised two sons, Sean and Tim. After they finished school, she got a master's degree and worked for the city of Bellevue. She was a dedicated churchgoer and lifelong member of the Presbyterian Education Organization, which united two of her favorite causes: education and religion. An accomplished musician, she played piano and sang in choirs throughout her life. A thoughtful and kind woman with a quietly wicked sense of humor, she made this world a better place.
