Harvey was born November 28, 1916 to James and Rosa (Hemenway) Harvey in a sod house on their homestead in Wheeler County, Nebraska near Spalding. He attended District 37 school. On August 11, 1935, he married Mabel Webb. They worked together on ranches in the area until March 1946. They moved to Ingam, NE and started farming for themselves on a farm they rented. He was on the District 68 school board. In 1951, they bought a farm near Loup City, NE. He was on the school board and also Chairman of the Sherman County Farm Bureau. He also worked in the Sherman County Assessor's office. In 1967, they moved to Kearney where Everett worked for Rockwell Mfg. Co. for 15 years. They then moved to Gibbon where he was active in the Good Samaritan Camping Club. He and Mabel loved to travel. They had visited all 50 states and most of the Providence's in Canada. Mabel, at the age of 93, passed away on November

10, 1999 after 64 years of marriage. In September of 2007, Everett moved to the Hearthside Assisted Living Center in Gibbon. He had recently moved to the Ashland Care Center to be closer to family. His survivors include his son, Don Harvey and his wife, Sharon of Ashland; daughter, Shirley Morgan and husband, Galen of Lincoln; 6 grandchildren; 8 great grandchildren; and 4 great great grandchildren; nieces and nephews. Everett was preceded in death by his wife; sister, Minnie Wolf; brother, Marion Harvey and a great grandson, Brandon Morgan.
