Harold and Leona Ruth Hunsberger were married in Washington D.C. on December 29, 1939. Born to this union were two daughters, Janice Elaine and Patricia Ann. Harold and Leona moved to Shelton, NE in 1943, where they lived the remainder of their 56 years of marriage. Leona passed away February 18, 1995. Harold and Agnes Louise King were married on August 3, 1996. They lived in Shelton until moving to Kearney in 2009. Harold was a government employee from 1939 until his retirement in 1986, the last 34 years with the Postal Service. He and Leona traveled and wintered in Apache Junction, Arizona and Texas for many years. He enjoyed wood carving, wood working projects, rock hunting, traveling and

reading. He was baptized at the Flagler Colorado Congregational Church in 1929. He transferred to the Shelton Methodist Church and was a member there since 1933. Harold was a member of Masonic Lodge for over 60 years.
