James Mullins, 85, of Kearney died Wednesday, January 6, 2010 at his residence. No services are planned. He was cremated. He fought at Normandy, France on Omaha Beach on June 6, 1944 and was honorably discharged on March 7, 1946. On September 24, 1948 he married Maida Lee Jensen in Oshkosh, NE. After his military service, he finished his high school education and attended Chadron State College, obtaining the degree of Bachelor of Science in Education. He then continued his education at Southwestern Bible Institute. He graduated with a Bachelor of Theology degree on May 23, 1952 and began his lifetime career as a minister. His career took him to churches in Nebraska, Kansas, Wyoming, Colorado and Hawaii. He was proud to have been able to perform the wedding ceremonies for both of his sons and their wives. He was a member of Faith United Methodist Church. His hobbies included football, especially the Nebraska Cornhuskers, reading, bowling and golf. He also had a great love for traveling and especially enjoyed being able to go with his sons to Normandy, France, to tour England and to see the White Cliffs of Dover. Survivors include his wife; sons, James Mullins and his wife, Susan of Evergreen, CO and Michael Mullins and his wife, Gail of Kearney; sister, June
