John Robert Noyes, retired Sergeant with the Missouri State Highway Patrol died at age 92 on July 22, 2021. He grew up in Troy, Kansas, and often shared memories of his youth. Notable was how he and the town's boys assisted in managing the day-to-day routines of a small town when the men went off to war during World War II. He pumped gas, delivered newspapers, became part of the fire department & ambulance crews, and assisted at a mortuary, owned by his brother-in law. He later worked for the Rural Electrification Administration (REA). The goal of the REA was to bring electricity to America's rural areas. He served in the US Army during the Korean War and was a lifetime member of the American Legion

Post 359. A brick honors his love for democracy at the National World War 1 memorial in Kansas City, Missouri. He served faithfully and honorably as a member of the Missouri State Highway Patrol stationed at Troop H in St. Joseph, Missouri for 32 years. Though he retired from the Patrol, his passion for service and protection was never extinguished.

He was preceded in death by his parents, two sisters and a daughter, Tammy Lynn Noyes. He leaves his wife Sharlyn Bogner. Daughters, Sheri Draper (Richard) and Phyllis Salanski (Steve), and son Mike Noyes. Grandchildren, Jennifer Hanneman (Casey), and Krista Sanderson, Douglas Salanski (Jillian) and Kristin Chandler (Jonathan).
