Larry D. Gilson, 75, of Kearney, formerly of North Platte, died Wednesday, November 4th at CHI Health Good Samaritan Hospital. Larry D. Gilson was born September 2, 1940 in Fullerton, Nebraska to Dale and Lois (Davis) Gilson. He graduated from Fullerton High School in 1958. Larry attended Peru State college earning his Bachelor's degree in 1962 with endorsements in Industrial Arts and Physical Education. On May 28, 1973, he was united in marriage to Thelma Jean Johnsen in North Platte, NE.

Larry served as a head basketball coach for Maxwell High School, Curtis Medicine Valley High School and Eustis Farnum High School. During his coaching career, Larry achieved one State championship, two state runner-ups, twelve state qualifying teams, seventeen conference championships and fifteen district championships. He amassed 576 wins (5th all-time) and 242 losses over his 39 years of coaching. Larry was also the co-contributor to the

“Gilson 6th Person Award,” a basketball honor for high school athletes throughout the state sponsored by The Huskerland Prep Report. He was a longtime member of the Nebraska Coaches Association.

Left to cherish his memory are his wife, Thelma Gilson of Kearney; sons, Randy Gilson (Montess Munoz) of Clay Center, NE and Tory Gilson of Kearney; granddaughter, Giselle Gilson; step grandson, Gabriel Munoz; brother, Dan Gilson; sisters-in-law, JoAnn Gilson and Linda Gilson; niece and nephews, Melissa, Justin, Patrick and Anthony Gilson.

Larry was preceded in death by his parents and brother, Douglas Gilson.
