Survivors include her daughters, Marlene Andrews and husband Loyd of Kearney and Marcella Helser of Cheyenne, WY. She was preceded in death by her parents; husband, Marvin; brother, Stewart Mayfield; and sister-in-law, Charlotte Mayfield.
