On April 22, 1994, LaVonne married Gilbert Loseke in Columbus, after which the couple moved to

Kearney. She was an active member of the First Lutheran Church of Kearney and served on the board for Camp Carol Joy Holing for many years. LaVonne volunteered at the Red Cross and the Humane Society. She and Gilbert enjoyed being members of Kiwana's Golden K Club. Gilbert passed away in October of 2012.
