Larry L. Schumacher, 79 of Kearney passed away Thursday, December 26, 2024 at CHI Good Samaritan Hospital in Kearney. Military honors will be provided by Kearney American Legion Post #52 and Kearney VFW Post #759 in conjunction with the U.S. Navy Funeral Honors Team.

Lawrence Lewis Schumacher was born October 30, 1945 in Tilden, Nebraska to Jerome and Blanche (McIntosh) Schumacher. He was raised in Genoa, NE and attended Genoa High School. Following graduation, Larry proudly served in U.S. Navy from 1965 until his honorable discharge in 1969. Larry later earned his degree from Kearney State College. He later worked at Coleman's and the City of Kearney.
