Leland Ray Soderquist died on Tuesday, October 30, 2018 (his 69th birthday) at Mosaic at Bethphage Village, Axtell NE. Funeral services will be at 10:30 a.m. on Wednesday, November 14, 2018 at Zion Chapel at Mosaic in Axtell. The Pastor John Gosswein will officiate. Interment will follow at Bethphage Cemetery in Axtell. The family will receive friends one hour prior to the service at the Zion Chapel.
