LeRoy Schulte, 84 of Kearney passed away Tuesday, February 27, 2024 at Good Samaritan Society, St. Luke's Village in Kearney. Memorial services will be 10:30 a.m. Saturday, March 16th, 2024 at Grace Fellowship Church in Kearney with Pastor Mitch Ivey Officiating.

LeRoy was born April 3, 1939 in Densmore, KS to William and Josephine (Vonfeldt) Schulte. He was raised in Densmore, KS and received his education from Densmore High School, graduating with the class of 1957. He later attended Ft. Hays State College from 1957-1961 earning his bachelor's degree in business administration. On November 7, 1958, LeRoy was united in marriage to Carolyn Graf in Densmore, KS. The couple made their home in Norton, KS where LeRoy worked for Norton Grain Company. In 1962, the couple moved to Kearney, NE where he worked at Caldwell Manufacturing, Deyle Construction and later was self-employed as a bookkeeper from 1965-2009 and a power washing business from 1997 to present.

LeRoy was a member of St. James Catholic Church. He was an avid Nebraska Football fan and enjoyed baseball, fishing, and landscaping.
