Louis "Butch" Siebenaler, 67 of Sumner passed away Friday, August 27, 2021 at Kearney Regional Medical Center in Kearney. He later moved to Sumner and started Butch's Repair. Butch was united in marriage to Donna Schutt in Sumner, NE. The couple was happily married until Donna's death in 1998.

Butch was often referred to as the King of Muscle Cars by his family and friends. He had a passion for racing. Butch was known for racing stock cars, drag racing and pickup pulls.

Left to cherish his memory are his brother, Steve (Kay) Siebenaler of Kearney; half-sisters, Kathleen Wilson, Linda Pfeifer and Ruth Sheibal all of Omaha and Sherry Clark of Grand Ronde, OR; several nieces and nephews; and many great nieces and great nephews.
