Marg once backed her brother Cliff's semi cattle truck up to a loading dock and the men around were pretty surprised and a few laughed, but she did it. In her later years she worked for Baldwin Filters in Kearney. Survivors include her husband, Warren of Gibbon; son, Brent Wise and wife Mona of Gibbon; grandsons, Jeff Wise and wife Nancy of Gibbon and Rusty Wise and wife Lisa of Holdrege; 6 great-grandchildren; and sister, Bonnie Gion of Fremont, CA. She was preceded in death by her sister, Evelyn Henry and brother, Cliff Ash.
