Marilyn H. Imel, 84, of Kearney, died Thursday, January 26, 2017 at Kearney Regional Medical Center.

Marilyn left her career in education to raise their three children; Terry, Cheryl and Julie. When their youngest child reached high school Marilyn began working at Baldwin Filters. In 2009 she retired after 30 plus years of

She was a member of First Lutheran Church.

Marilyn and Lyle were rarely apart. Their most enjoyable times were attending the activities of their beloved children, grandchildren and great grandchildren. She always looked forward to socializing at Peterson Senior Activity Center, and also enjoyed gardening, sewing and baking her famous chocolate chip cookies. Mr. Imel preceded her in death on March 7, 2014.
