Marv Elliott, 88 of Kearney passed away Tuesday, April 27, 2021 in Elkhorn, Nebraska. Funeral services will be held at 10:30 AM Monday, May 3, 2021 at First Lutheran Church in Kearney. The Rev. Dr. Michelle Holley Carlson and Rev. Dr. Rick Carlson will officiate. Interment will follow at Kearney Cemetery. Visitation will be held 4:00 to 6:00 p.m. Sunday, May 2nd at O'Brien Straatmann Redinger Funeral Home in Kearney.

Marv was born November 7, 1932 in Odessa, Nebraska to Everett and Ruby (Fleharty) Elliott. He graduated from Kearney High School with the class of 1950. In February of 1951, Marv enlisted in the United States Navy and proudly served until his honorable discharge in January of 1955. After serving his country, he returned to the Kearney/Odessa area where he has lived all his life. In April of 1955, he married Joyce Foged at First Lutheran Church and was married 48 years to Joyce until her passing in November of 2003. Marv farmed and ran a Holstein dairy operation with his brother, Lyle for 30 years. In 1985, they sold the dairy herd and Marv explored the residential real estate world before entering public service for the District Court in Kearney. He served two judges during his nearly 30 year tenure as bailiff.

Marv was a member of First Lutheran Church in Kearney, The Eagles Club, the American Legion and is a past member of the B.P.O.E. (Kearney Elks Lodge) Marv enjoyed St. Louis Cardinals' baseball, golfing, fishing and woodworking.

Left to cherish his memory are his sons, Mitch (Kim) Elliott of Bennington, NE, and Matt (Angela) Elliott of Davey, NE; daughter, Jodi (Calvin) Treat of St. Louis, MO; 8 grandchildren; 5 great grandchildren; sisters-in-law, Patricia Elliott of Kearney and Andrea King of Broomfield, CO; as along with extended family and many, life-long friends.

He was preceded in death by his wife, Joyce (Foged) Elliott; his parents and his brother, Lyle.
