Marvin LeRoy Walker, 76, Kearney resident died Tuesday, May 8, 2013, at the Mother Hull Home in Kearney. He is survived by his wife Ann Walker of Kearney; sons, Marc Walker of Ft. Polk, LA, Kyle and wife Sue Simodynes of Kearney; daughters Kim Walker of Grand Island, Sarah and husband Craig Armbruster of Kearney and 4 grand children.
