Mary Lucille Boyd, 96, of Kearney, died Monday, June 13, 2016 at Mount Carmel Home Keens Memorial.

Mary was born on May 7, 1920 southeast of Shelton in rural Hall County to Chester and Elsie (Lowell) Smith. She attended school in rural Buffalo county until moving to Gibbon when she was in the seventh grade. In 1938 she graduated from Gibbon High School.

She was united in marriage to J. Everette Jensen on October 4, 1940 in Norton, Kansas. They made their home in Lincoln, NE and Los Angeles, CA while Everette served in the military. Upon his honorable discharge they returned to Gibbon to live with their two children. Everette preceded her in death in April of 1965 from complications of Multiple Sclerosis. While living in Gibbon Mary worked for the school lunch program for five years.

On September 8, 1968 she was united in marriage to Charles Boyd in Vacaville, CA. The couple made their home in Robbins, CA before moving to Sacramento. While living in California they bought and managed apartment complexes. In 1980 they sold the apartment complexes and returned to Gibbon where they raised vegetables to sell at the farmer's market. Charles preceded her in death in August of 1984. Mary continued to make her home in Gibbon.

She is survived by her son, Larry Jensen and wife Patricia of Omaha; a daughter, Joanne Bryant and husband Murray of Woodland, CA; three sisters, Doretha (Bob) Clevenger of Gibbon, Bernadean Wilke of Loveland, CO and Berniece Slack of Kearney; six grandchildren; 15 great grandchildren; several step children and step grandchildren; and numerous nieces and nephews.

Preceded in death by her parents, her two husbands, three sisters and two brothers.
