Mary M. Dennis, 53 of Wilcox, died Thursday, Dec. 4, 2014 at her residence. Funeral services will be 2:00 PM, Tuesday, Dec. 9, 2014 at First United Methodist Church in Kearney. The Rev. Gary Main will officiate. Interment will be in the Kearney Cemetery. Visitation will be 5-7 PM, Monday at O'Brien Straatmann Redinger Funeral Home in Kearney and continue one hour prior to service time at the church. Mary Margaret (Straka) Dennis was born January 4, 1961 to Donald and Catherine (Meuret) Straka in Atkinson, NE. She graduated from West Holt High School in 1979. Mary then attended Kearney State College where she earned a degree in early childhood education in the spring of 1983. Her first teaching job was with the Ansley Public Schools teaching first grade. It was there she met her future husband, Steve Dennis. Mary and Steve were united in marriage on August 4, 1984. They were blessed with three sons: Benjamin, Andrew, and Derek. Mary was a caring, loving, and devoted mother and put her teaching career on hold to stay home with her boys during their preschool years. After two years in Creighton, NE, the family made their new home in Ord, NE. When her youngest, Derek, was ready to start school she restarted her teaching career as the kindergarten teacher at Ord St. Mary's. Derek was one of her students that year. She taught at St. Mary's for 18 years. In 2012, Mary and Steve moved to Wilcox, NE where she worked at the Phelps County

Assessor's Office in Holdrege, NE. Mary will be fondly remembered and greatly missed.

She is survived by her husband Steve Dennis, her son Benjamin and his wife Jennifer Dennis of York, Andrew Dennis and his fiancé Nicole Lubberstedt of Norfolk, and Derek Dennis of Lincoln. Also surviving Mary are her parents Donald and Catherine Straka of Kearney, brothers Steve (Anne) Straka of Buda, TX, Gerard (Nicole) Straka of Kearney, Joe (Heidi) Straka of Kearney, and sister Maureen (Dan) Bird of Burwell, mother-in-law Ellen Dennis of Arnold, brother-in-laws Tom and Dave (Robbin) Dennis of Lexington, and Lucinda Dennis of Funk.
