Matthew Lindsay, 28, of Kearney, died Thursday, May 29, 2014 at his home. Funeral services will be 10:00 AM, Tuesday at First United Methodist Church in Kearney. The Rev. Gary Main will officiate. The casket will be closed at the church. Interment will be in the Kearney Cemetery. Visitation will be 5-7 PM, Monday at the O'Brien Straatmann Redinger Funeral Home in Kearney. Matthew was born October 7, 1985 in Janesville, Wisconsin to William and Jill Lynn (Pickens) Lindsay. He was baptized at the Janesville Methodist Church. At the age of 4, he moved to Geneva, IL. While living in Geneva, his mother was killed in an automobile accident. He moved with his dad and sister to Kearney in 1990. He went to Northeast Elementary School and Kearney Catholic High School. He graduated from KCHS in 2004. While at KCHS, he ran cross-country and played soccer. He was confirmed at the First Presbyterian Church in Kearney.

Matt graduated from UNK in 2009 with a degree in sports management. After completing an internship with the Indianapolis Ice in Indianapolis, he moved to Chicago where he worked for the Chicago Fire of MLS Soccer Team and for Dick's Sporting Goods. After his cancer diagnosis, he moved back to Kearney. Matt loved sports of all kinds. He was an avid Chicago sports fan with the

Blackhawks, Bears, White Sox and Fire as his favorite teams. He was a great Husker Football fan and was so proud of his brother, Spencer being on the team.

Survivor include his father and step-mother, Katherine Keifer of Kearney, brother, Spencer of Kearney and sister, Elizabeth Lindsay of Axtell, grandparents, Charlotte Lindsay of Wethersfield, CT and Charles and Beverly Pickens of Kearney, and his basset hound, Bailey.

He was preceded in death by his mother, Jill, grandparents, Robert Lindsay and Jess and Willa Keifer.
