He and Claire have owned and operated the Lodge Restaurant in Kearney for several years. In September 1997 he was raised to the Sublime Degree of a Master Mason in Rob Morris Lodge #46 of the AF and AM. He became a member of the Hastings Valley of Scottish Rite December 13, 1997. On December 5, 2005, he received his Knights Commander Court of Honor Red Cap. On December 5, 2009, he received the Coronation of White Cap as a 33rd Degree Scottish Rite Mason. He was initiated into Tehama Shrine on December 13, 1997. In 2007 he was appointed to the Shrine Soccer Committee and served as
