



Pascualita Huerta

February 3, 1918 - January 13, 2010

Sr. Pascualita C. Huerta, 91, of Kearney died Wednesday, January 13, 2010 at Mt. Carmel Home in Kearney. A Mass of Christian Burial will be held at 10:00 AM, Saturday, January 16 at St. James Catholic Church with Revs. Jim O'Connor, Thomas Mallowney and Mike McDonald officiating. Interment will be in the Kearney Cemetery. Visitation will be from 4:30 - 6:30 PM, Friday at the O'Brien - Straatmann Funeral Home, with a prayer vigil at 5:30 PM. O'Brien - Straatmann Funeral Home of Kearney is in charge of arrangements. She was born February 3, 1918 in Durango, Mexico to Pascual and Maria (Espiro) Huerta. She came to the United States with her family to escape religious persecution. She obtained U.S. citizenship in September 1945. Sr. Pascualita became a member of the Corpus Christi Congregation in 1942 and soon began teaching Religious Education to the children of Scottsbluff, Kearney and Lincoln City, Oregon. Sister also helped to care for the elderly in the Mt. Carmel Home. She was chosen for the office of Secretary General and took up those duties at the Mother House in Tunapuna, Trinidad from 1978 to 1984, and then returned to Kearney. Sister continued her work as a chatechist as well as working in the Mt. Carmel Home. The survivors of her immediate family are brothers, Joe Huerta of Mission Viejo, CA, Conrad Huerta and wife Nellie of Elwood, NE, Salvador Huerta and wife Helen of Gering, NE, Pascual Huerta, Jr. and wife Laura of Brighton, CO, Philip Huerta and wife Lori of

Roswell, NM, and Patrick Huerta and wife, Franca of Zollikofen, Switzerland;
and sisters, Teresa Ramirez of Cheyenne, WY, Rita Garcia of Versailles, MO,
Cora Lucius of Gering, NE and Mary Blanchard of Wray, CO She was
