In the 1950s they moved to a farm northeast of Kearney where they owned and operated Lewis Feedlot. Mr. Lewis preceded her in death on April 11, 2004.

Patricia was a member of First Lutheran Church. She enjoyed gardening, quilting, sewing, putting together puzzles, reading and attending auctions with her friends. Most of all, she loved spending time with her family and friends, and always loved following her children's and grandchildren's activities.
