Richard D. Crow, 83 of Kearney, died Tuesday, June 14, 2016 at the Nebraska Veterans Home in Grand Island. A Mass of Christian Burial will be held 10:30 a.m. Friday at St. James Catholic Church in Kearney. Father Art Faesser will officiate. Interment will be at 2:30 pm Friday at Ft. McPherson National Cemetery in Maxwell, Nebraska with military honors provided by the North Platte Honor Team in conjunction with the Nebraska National Guard. He entered into the U.S. Army in March of 1953 where he served in Germany until he was honorably discharged in March of 1955. On January 22, 1957, Richard was united in marriage to Frances Iona Ripp at the Immaculate Conception Catholic Church in Elm Creek, NE. Richard began working for Union Pacific Railroad at the

age of 17. He and his family moved to North Platte in 1972. The couple then moved back to Kearney following his retirement in 1995.

Richard was a member of St. James Catholic Church and the Kearney American Legion Post # 52.
