Robert L. "Bob" Fulton, 95 of Kearney died Wednesday, June 20, 2012 at St. John's Good Samaritan Center in Kearney. A Celebration of Life service will be 11:00 AM, Saturday at O'Brien - Straatmann - Redinger Funeral Home in Kearney. Interment will be held at a later date at Fort Logan National Cemetery in Denver, CO. Military rites will be conducted at graveside. He graduated from high school at West High School in Denver. Robert served in the Army 347th Infantry Division during WWII. He was a Purple Heart recipient. After his discharge in 1945, he was married to Virginia "Gini" Kellums on August 18, 1946 in Denver. He was a commercial artist and worked for Advertising Display in Denver. He and his wife loved entertaining guests in their home in Denver. Bob performed on stage at Elitch Gardens as a child and later sang in the Cheesman Park Opera in Denver. Bob was the in house artist for the Denver Orpheum Theatre and the artistic designer for the Lakeside Amusement Park from the 1940's until moving to the Northridge Retirement Community in Kearney in 2008. He was the soloist at Divine Science Church in Denver for many years and sang for many churches over his life time. Survivors include his wife of Kearney, son, Barry and wife, Jennie of Grand Junction, CO, daughters, Terree Warren and

husband, Jim of Kearney, Sherree Cordova and husband, Arnie of Highlands Ranch, CO, grandchildren; Trevor Fulton, Brooke Sequist, Ryan McEntee, Charlie and Steve Cordova, great-granddaughter, Sophia Cordova, sisters; Dora Liggett of Denver and Charlyn Boord of Santa Rosa, CA. Also surviving are several nieces and nephews. He was preceded in death by his parents.
