Robert "Bob" Wallace, 78, of Tucson, Ariz., died Monday, April 18, 2011, in Kearney. A celebration of life gathering will be at 2 p.m. Sunday at the home of Scott Wallace at 104 E. 28th St. Bob was born April 24, 1932, in Eddyville to Edward and Mabel (Sell) Wallace. His mother, Mabel, died when Robert was a baby. Edward then married Bob's aunt, Margaret Sell, who became his true mother. Bob grew up in the Sumner area and graduated from Sumner High School. He was a Korean War veteran, serving from 1952 to 1954. Using the GI Bill, Bob completed barber college in 1955 and barbered in Kearney until 1968 when the family moved to Tucson. Survivors include his wife of 60 years, Phyllis; sons, Michael and his wife, Karen, and Mark and his wife, Cindy, all of Tucson and Scott of Kearney; and daughter, Alice Bauman and husband, Ron of Flagstaff, AZ; ten grandchildren; nine great-grandchildren; brothers, James and his wife, Jane, of Loveland, CO, and Charles and his wife, LouAnn, of Alamogordo, NM; sisters, Ruth Kresser of Kearney and Norma Eby of Overton; brother-in-law, Dwane Cramer of Sumner; and sister-in-law, Darlene Wallace of Nebraska City.
