Sharon Kuhl Huddleston, 88 of Kearney passed away Thursday, June 12, 2025 at her home surrounded by family. Graveside services will be 2:00 p.m. Sunday, July 20, 2025 at Evergreen Cemetery in Loup City, NE. A luncheon will follow at the Rockville Gymnasium.

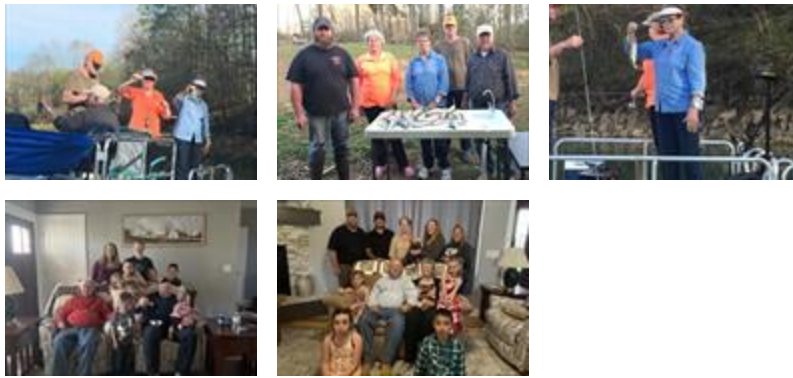
