Sharon R. Meyers, 77 of Kearney passed away Thursday, September 10, 2020 at her home in Kearney. Funeral Services will be held 10:30 Thursday, September 17, 2020 at St. James Catholic Church with Father Jonathan Sorensen officiating. Interment will follow at Kearney Cemetery. Visitation will be 5:00 to 7:00 p.m. Wednesday at O'Brien Straatmann Redinger Funeral Home in Kearney and one hour prior to the service at the church.

Sharon was born March 12, 1943 in Minden, Nebraska to Lloyd and Ruby (Eckhardt) Moon. She was raised by Lee and Mildred McGown in Kearney where she attended Kearney High School. On February 7, 1964, Sharon married LeRoy Meyers in Kearney, NE. Later that same year they welcomed their first of three daughters.
