Shirley was a member of the First Presbyterian Church of Broken Bow where she served as Financial Secretary, Sunday School teacher, and a member of Latrea Circle. 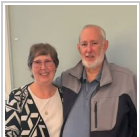

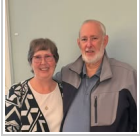
