Rose Dolores Hoelting, 89 Kearney Resident Sr. Rose Dolores Hoelting, 89 of Kearney died Thursday, June 28, 2012 at Mt. Carmel Home in Kearney. Mass of Christian Burial will be 10:30 AM, Tuesday at St. James Catholic Church in Kearney. The Rev. Tom Mullaney will officiate. Interment will be in the Kearney Cemetery. Visitation will be held 4-7 PM Monday at the Mt. Carmel Chapel. A rosary will follow at 7PM. Memorials are suggested to the Corpus Christi Carmelite Sisters. Sr. Rose Dolores Hoelting was born Cecilia Edna Hoelting to John and Dorothy Hoelting on June 24, 1923 in Oconto, NE. She was accepted into the Congregation of Corpus Christi Carmelite Sisters in Kearney on May 27, 1948. She did her religious training in Kearney and made her Final Vows here on February 11, 1953. She was assigned to work in Duluth, MN and was in charge of making altar bread from 1958 to 1967. She then returned to Mt. Carmel Home to help with the nursing and care of the elderly. At some point, she completed three courses in nursing and received a diploma from the Chicago School of Nursing in February 1954. Sr. Rose Dolores celebrated her 50th Jubilee with the Corpus Christi Carmelite Congregation July 22, 1998 in Kearney. Sr. Rose Dolores was one of the kindest, most loving and caring persons you would ever meet. She would always go that "extra mile" and was so thoughtful, showering love and affection all the way. She was the last of the hard-working Sisters who pioneered Mt. Carmel Home from its small

beginning to what it is today. She had a keen sense of humor and a twinkle in her eye. She was witty and could always come up with a saying that would make you laugh. At her 89th birthday party, with over 50 of her family members there, when she saw the huge birthday cake with the 89 candles, she joked, "Well, I'm not eighteen you know." After giving her life to "Serving the Lord with Gladness", she slipped away peacefully to meet her God. Now, she is safely home.
