He received his education from rural school in Ashton, NE. He entered into the United States Army on October 22, 1952 and served during the Korean War. He was honorably discharged on July 21, 1954 after being injured and receiving the Purple Heart. On November 9, 1957, Stanley was united in marriage to Vida Eloie at the St. James Catholic Church in Kearney. Stanley started Central Piping and Repair on January 1, 1977 and was active in the business to this day. He enjoyed Hunting, Dancing, playing cards, and antique cars. He will always be remembered for his consistent hard work throughout his life, the ability to play the accordion and the love he had for his family. Stanley was a member of the St. James Catholic Church,

American Legion, VFW and the Eagles Club.
