Steven Franklin Greuter, passed away on April 17, 2026, at Good Samaritan – St Luke’s Nursing Home surrounded by the persons he loved.

Steven was born on April 15, 1952, in Hastings to Evelyn (Kitts) and Ivan N. Greuter. He was born the youngest of eleven children.
