Susan C. Lynch, 70 years of age, of Kearney, passed away on Sunday, August 19, 2018 at Kearney Regional Medical Center in Kearney. Memorial Services will be held on Thursday, August 23, 2018 at 10:30 a.m. at O'Brien-Straatmann-Redinger Funeral Home in Kearney, with Pastor Paul Stephen Duffy officiating.

Susan was born July 29, 1948 to John and Loree (Williams) Wolter in Salina, Kansas. She was later adopted by Eugene Maddux in Salina, Kansas. Susan attended high school in Bangor, Maine where she graduated with the class of 1966. Following her education, Susan was united in marriage to William McFerrin, the couple later divorced.

Susan was united in marriage to Chandler S. Lynch on April 13, 1991 in Kearney, Nebraska. The couple made their home in Kearney, where they owned and managed Midtown Communications for many years. In recent years, Susan had made her lifelong ambition a reality by creating the Noteworthy Studio in Kearney. Susan's dream was to create a venue where local musicians could come to jam. When she first opened the studio it was located at Chapman Swifts, and most recently is located at 2117 Avenue A in Kearney.

At the age of 69, Susan became interested in guns and shooting skills. She was quite proficient with her .357 Revolver and received her conceal and

carry permit.

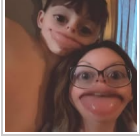
