Virginia then attended Sillima University in Dumaguete, Negros Oriental, where she studied accounting and chemistry, later earning her degree in Chemistry. She taught chemistry in the Philippines and later in the United States. On February 22, 1979, she was united in marriage to Dennis Lund. Virginia was proud to have received her United States citizenship in 1986.

She served as the curator of the Frank House (G.W. Frank Museum of History

and Culture) from July of 1990 until her retirement in October of 2004. Virginia was a very accomplished and refined woman. She was known for being extremely social and for hosting formal tea parties.
