Walter E. Treadway, 88, of Kearney, died Friday, January 22, 2016 at the CHI Health Good Samaritan Hospital in Kearney. Walter Emerson Treadway was born January 29, 1927 in North Platte, Nebraska to Clyde L. and Irene A. (O'Dea) Treadway. He received his education from Kearney Catholic High School graduating in 1944. Later that year he enlisted in the U.S. Coast Guard. He served until his honorable discharge in 1946. In 1947, Walter was united in marriage to Fyrne Ingram in Hastings, NE. The couple had met while working at Western T.V. Later they

moved to Yankton, SD where he helped build the Gavin Point Dam. The couple would later move back to Kearney where Walter worked as a carpenter for Amos Wedell. Walter spent the next 25 years as a route manager for Sunshine Biscuits. He also worked at Liebers and Stumbo Heating and Air for several years before retiring. Fynre passed away in 1993 after 46 years of marriage. Walter would later marry Colleen Gove in 1995.

Walter was a member of the VFW #759, Eagle's and the Elks Club and attended Holy Cross Lutheran Church. He enjoyed carpentry and spending time with his family. Walter knew no strangers and always enjoyed his conversations with his family and numerous friends.
