Wayne George Weiser was born July 1, 1928 in Wolbach, Nebraska to Lloyd and Bessie (Elliott) Weiser. He attended school in the Wolbach area. Wayne worked at the Cornhusker Army Ammunition Plant until 1946 when he enlisted in the United States Navy. He served until he was honorably discharged in 1949. In 1954, Wayne was united in marriage to Cleona Bonsack. The couple made their home in Fernley, NV where Wayne worked as a mill operator and acting supervisor. While in Fernley, NV, he joined the volunteer fire department as a fireman and ambulance attendant. He later would become fire chief and earn his honorary fireman silver badge. In 1969, they moved to Shelton, NE where he worked at Cypress Industries in Grand Island. He retired in 1983.

Survivors include his sons Delbert (Jill) Weiser of Shelton and Doug Weiser of

Overton; daughter Dianna (Jeff) Dixon of Hastings; grandchildren Thomas J. Smith, Jackilyn (Brandon) Bell, Kyle (Katie) Weiser; great grandchildren Gabriel Bell, Isabell Weiser and Isaac Weiser. Wayne was preceded in death by his parents; wife, Cleona; brothers Darwin, Melvin and Lloyd Weiser; sisters Valda Christensen and Shirley Geohring.
